TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. Introduction

- (a) These terms and conditions apply for The Neff Kitchen Competition (*the Competition*) promoted by Sampford IXL Pty Ltd (*the Promoter*).
- (b) Information on entry to this competition and the prizes for part of these Terms and Conditions.
- (c) Entry into the draw is deemed acceptance for these conditions of entry.
- (d) The Promoter's failure to enforce any one of these terms will not give rise to any claim or right of action by any other person or participant.

2. Duration

The promotion commences on 12/08/2011 at 9:00 am (AEST) and closes on 16/09/2011 at 11:59pm (AEST) ("the Promotion Period"). Your entry must be received by us by no later than the closing time.

3. Eligibility

- (a) Only Australian residents are eligible to enter the Competition.
- (b) The Promoter's employees and their immediate family, associated agencies and companies associated with the Competition are not eligible to enter the Competition.
- (c) All persons must own a Neff kitchen appliance to be eligible to enter.

4. How to participate
